Senegal

- US\$ 2,257 million (9.0% of total) contribution of tourism to GDP
- 359,400 tourism jobs (9.0% of total)



The Gambia

- US\$ 292 million (14.8% of total) contribution of tourism to GDP
- 116,400 tourism jobs (16.4% of total)



Zambia

- US\$ 1,597 million (7.4% of total) contribution of tourism to GDP
- 478,000 tourism jobs (7.4% of total)



Uganda

- US\$ 2,411 million (5.9% of total) contribution of tourism to GDP
- 671,000 tourism jobs (4.1% of total)



Rwanda

- US\$ 1,150 million (11.4% of total) contribution of tourism to GDP
- 385,0000 tourism jobs (6.1% of total)



Tanzania

- US\$ 6,663 million (10.6% of total) contribution of tourism to GDP
- 1.53 million tourism jobs (6.1% of total)



Mozambique

Laos
